## **Fundraising Committee Update:**

- 50/50 Back to School Raffle reverted to host on Raffle Box instead of Raffle Rocket since this is
  more user friendly and not bound to miscellaneous subscriptions. Reminder to purchase tickets

#### New Business/Carryover Topics/Action Items from Previous meeting: Mr. Bester

- Internal form created for staff to use to list ideas, suggestion that can be presented at the meeting. Staff can list the number of students, impact on school development on these forms.
- Art Team would like to invite Indigenous Artists for workshop on Inuit Carvings. Cost is \$2000.00.



Students will pay \$20.00. Motion to allocate \$1000.00 for residency art department to be split over 2 semesters, motion to allocate \$500.00 for this semester, by Sara,  $2^{nd}$  Tavis. All in favor. Motion carried.

- Increasing requests to support transportation for non-curricular events example dance troupe travel, robotics team travel and field trip costs. Affects 600 students each of the 2 semesters. Some of the field trips cannot access RAM. Request of \$5000.00 (\$2500.00 will be split over 2 semesters). Motion to allocate \$2500.00 for this semester (funding model will be reviewed in he second semester) approved by Tavis. All in favor. Motion carried.
- Request of \$500.00 to support Trail tribune acquire supplies and materials. Motion by Sara, 2<sup>nd</sup> Farah. All in favor. Motion carried.
- Cost of 3 day backpacking outdoor pursuits (Heart Mountain) campsite fee is \$312.00. Motion to support funding up to \$350.00 by Elaine, 2<sup>nd</sup> April. All in favor. Motion carried.
- Still awaiting final cost of Mascot.
- Discussion about acquiring a school bus. The cost is up to \$150,000.00, school looking into leasing a bus or small tubby busses in the meanwhile.
