Credit Completion = Students attend classes by teacher request. This is an opportunity for students to demonstrate an understanding of outcomes when the student is close to but has not yet demonstrated success in a course.

Dear families,

We want to share with you our end of semester, assessment and reporting calendar. Please have a look at these important dates and daily expectations. Students need to attend classes and access learning until January 19, 2024 (attendance will be taken until January 19, 2024) and then may have additional learning time from January 22-24, 2024.

Please make time to look at your child's achievements as itemized on PowerSchool and discuss areas where outcomes or modules have not yet been completed successfully. Students wishing to demonstrate further learning should communicate with their teacher and may be able to advance their work on January 22 – 24. Opportunities in the different classes will vary and student/teacher communication is important. Information will be shared with students daily which is why consistent and daily attendance is needed.

On January 17 and 18, students will have opportunities to complete summative assessments to provide evidence of what they have learned. This may include project work, conversations with teachers, or final exams. Teachers will communicate expectations to students in class, on D2L (Brightspace), or via messenger.



Students will spend some time in their classes preparing for these assessments. During Trail Time on December 20. and January 10. teachers will assist students with planning their studying and discuss what learning supports are available in each class. For example, help may be available during tutorial times, and review activities may be planned during class or materials may be available on D2L. Students will also reflect on their learning to date and where they must still demonstrate understandings.

On January 29. we have Appeals Day. On this day, students can seek clarification about a final grade in a course. Generally, a student would have had ongoing conversations with their teacher throughout the semester and should have a good understanding of their progress. The student and teacher would have met to discuss achievement and examine the evidence of learning by a student. If, at the end of a semester, a student still has questions about their grade, please follow up with their teacher on or before Appeals Day.

Once semester 1 is completed, students will start new courses on January 31. They will find their new schedule on PowerSchool on January 31.
